Advanced Project Management Course:

Course Description

This course is for project managers who are studying to take the PMP® or CAPM® exam. Course includes 35-40 hours of pre-classroom training, memory sheets, flash cards, quick reference guide, practice tests, textbook, and PSIPM's propriety reference book. Forty hours of classroom instruction is conducted on a Monday - Friday basis.

The Advanced Project Management Course is a five-week training program for aspiring PMP® or CAPM® candidates. Four weeks of precourse study is completed before the actual classroom instruction begins. During the four weeks prior to the class, reading and other assignments will be assigned, and the progress will be followed by the instructor. Weekly study groups will be conducted to enhance the students learning experience and answer any questions the student may have. Precourse simulated exam testing is also conducted during the precourse work to assist the student in preparing for the actual exam.

As an ATP, PSIPM uses the PMI developed textbook for the actual classroom instruction. In addition, other learning tools and practical applications are also provided during the class. The instructor for the course is a PMI Authorized Training Instructor who has broad project management experience and extensive experience teaching project management.

The instructor works with the students on an individual basis as they prepare for the exam and they also assist the student with completing the application.

All courses are conducted virtually and are guaranteed to run.

Learning Objectives

This is a comprehensive project management course that prepares candidates for the PMP® or the CAPM® exam. This course consists of 35-40 hours of precourse self-paced training which is facilitated by an instructor and 40 hours of virtual classroom instruction. PMI's Authorized PMP® Exam Prep book is used for the classroom instruction. Additional PSIPM material is also used to enhance the learning experience. The course has a two-fold learning objective: First of all, prepare the students for the PMP® or the CAPM® exam. Secondly, to provide tools the student can apply in their day-to-day projects. The course focuses on:

After completing this course the student should be fluent in all of the areas and prepared for the appropriate exam.
